

**VINCENT GIRARDIN, Meursault****Vincent Girardin 2008 Pouilly-Fuissé** 15.5 Drink 2011-2013

Fine, fresh restraint on the nose and pretty tight and mineral on the palate. Lean rather than thin. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Les Clous Premier Cru 2008 Rully** 15.5 Drink 2011-2013

A savoury edge to the citrus aroma. Quite light on the palate: tight and mineral and lingering but no great depth. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Vieilles Vignes 2008 Chassagne-Montrachet** 16.5 Drink 2011-2015

50-year-old vines. Finely oaky nose. Creamy citrus. Broad in the mouth with a spiced edge and just enough freshness. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Vieilles Vignes 2008 Puligny-Montrachet** 17 Drink 2011-2016

50-year-old vines. Mineral restraint and a smoky reductive layer that invites you in. Finesse and real clarity. Good length, too. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Clos des Charrons 2008 Meursault** 17 Drink 2012-2017

Smoky with the merest hint of smoky bacon and a light reductive note. But also a freshness of herbs. Dense and creamy on the palate yet nicely restrained. Long. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, En Remilly Premier Cru 2008 St-Aubin** 16.5 Drink 2011-2014

Much more initial impact than the Rully Les Clous. Hint of clementine skin but also a light overlay of creamy, nutty oak. Richer on the palate too and a streak of freshness to counterbalance the richness of the fruit and creamy texture. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Clos du Cailleret Premier Cru 2008 Chassagne-Montrachet** 17 Drink 2012-2018

Fresh yet flattering. Rich, lightly spiced and an underlying power. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Les Combettes Premier Cru 2008 Puligny-Montrachet** 16.5 Drink 2011-2015

Bright and citrusy on the nose. Clean and crisp but not as long as the Chassagne-Montrachet Clos du Cailleret. (JH)

**Vincent Girardin, Grand Cru 2008 Corton-Charlemagne** 17.5 Drink 2013-2020

Intense and smoky with a delicate vanilla perfume. Flattering and generous on the palate, a touch smoky, dry, sustained and quite oaky at the moment but well balanced. (JH)
